- Student Transcripts (Unofficial transcripts are acceptable)
- Letter of Recommendation from Construction Management Program Faculty Member
- Industry Letter of Recommendation and/or Letter of Personal Reference
- Any additional supporting documentation or letters are encouraged, but not required
- Students are encouraged to document their participation in the following areas:
 - CM Student Association activities (including Reno Competition)
 - Donation of time to outside organizations
 - Other activities within the school or community
 - Awards and commendations

Scholarship Submission Process

- Completed checklist and documents for the 2019 SRBXEF Construction Management Scholarship must be **received** by 5:00 p.m. Monday March 25, 2019, for consideration. Submissions may be sent via e-mail to kcarbone@srbx.org or by mail to the Sacramento Regional Builders Exchange, 5370 Elvas Avenue, Sacramento, CA 95819. Please submit all documents in one package.
- Following a review of completed application packets, SRBXEF will contact those applicants who will be invited to participate in a Skype interview on Thursday, April 4, 2019. Applicants must participate in the interview process for final consideration.
- Successful candidates will be invited to the SRBXEF Design Build Competition Industry Lunch at Cosumnes River College on May 2, 2019.
